How Have We Helped?

The following statistics reflect the number of people and demographics requesting assistance through the IRAS office between October I, 2019 and September 30, 2020.

5,742 residents requested assistance

How Have We Helped

Services Report

Of the requests for assistance received, we helped in the following ways:

Housing Stability

- 6I individuals received assistance with utilities to remain in their homes or deposits to move into new homes
- 195 individuals received assistance with their rental payments allowing them to remain in their homes
- Provided 91 nights to 54 individuals though our motel voucher program

Filling the Gaps

- 2,155 households including 5,391 individuals were assisted with food through Pantries United
- 2,307 households including 5,681 individuals were assisted with 46,819 pounds of food and 62,599 meals through our quarterly Mobile Food Pantries
- 171 children were assisted with weekend food packages each week
- Provided 200 Fareway gift cards and emergency food to replace food lost during Derecho
- 47 individuals were assisted with transportation to work, doctor's appointments and school
- 39 individuals were helped with obtaining the documentation so they could receive state aid or begin work
- 55 individuals were assisted with the purchase of eyeglasses
- 92 individuals were assisted with purchasing necessary prescription medication
